Caring Community Grants

Each year, Sequoia Healthcare District provides Caring Community grants to local non-profits and government organizations that provide crucial health services for the residents of our area. These grants serve collectively approximately 60,000 residents. Additionally, the District also funds community health clinics and several other health services, including school-based health programs.

Funding priorities are based on current and projected community health needs and variable funding resources. The Community Grants priority funding areas have been identified as:

- Youth and Adult Health Literacy
- Senior Services
- Substance Prevention + Treatment
- Clinical/Medical
- Behavioral Health




